## **Background and Data Sources**

Mobile apps and commission free trading have led to an explosion of retail participation in financial markets. We wanted to dive more quantitatively into the interactions between these mobile phone traders and financial markets.

#### **ROBINHOOD**



- May 2, 2018 to August 13, 2020
- Hourly data on number of distinct Robinhood users holding the stock
- Sourced from robintrack.net
- Does not include options data
- Not perfect: missing Jan 06 to 16, 2020
- 8,597 CSV files
- 3.44 GB

### WRDS/COMPUSTAT



- Financial metrics & stock prices
- Includes columns for splits and dividends
- Total return imputed in preprocessing
- Includes prices each day at close, open, high, and low
- Sourced directly through WRDS

- 4.38 GB total (w/ Robintrack)


#### **KAGGLE/REDDIT**




- Data from inception to August 15, 2020
- Dump of all posts to r/wallstreetbets
- Pulled dates & tickers mentioned from this data
- Spikes tend to coincide with security news
- Used to select popular stocks to investigate manually

### Selected r/wallstreetbets Reaction


Jan 03, 2020: Defense Stocks Are Jumping After U.S. Airstrike Raises Tensions in Middle East (<u>Barron's</u>).

Jan 07, 2020: Joke post reaches Reddit overall front page and all-time most popular list in subreddit drives holdings up on days old news (Reddit, pictured right).

Unfortunately, data is missing Jan 06 to Jan 16, but the trend is clear. Robinhood distinct users holding these stocks saw an unusually large jump on the joke, days after the pop (in stock and holdings) on the news.
